Water Quality Goals
10/26/07

1. Median water clarity shall be equal to or greater than 24 inches.
2. Create and maintain a healthy diverse aquatic habitat that supports a balanced population of fish and wildlife.
3. Stabilize areas of eroding shoreline.
4. Optimize the operation of the Mosquito Creek inflow system to maintain water quality and lake level goals.
5. Dredge the lake to optimize water quality and depth while achieving DOT and DNR goals.
6. Develop and implement educational outreach programs to increase public awareness of how daily activities affect Lake Manawa's water quality.
7. Develop a water balance for the lake which identifies and quantifies all the inflows and outflows which impact water quality or water levels.
